How we achieve our goals



Governance

- With the help of our the Board of CWK we are able to achieve anything we put our minds to.
- Accountability and transparency are key values that we strive to uphold in all our dealings.
- Assuring strong governance that oversees, guides and supports effective delivery of agreed programs and actions is a priority of Child Welfare South Africa Kleinmond.

Subsidy received DSD

- Funding is not enough to make our organization fully operational.
- Only 5 of the 8 positions are subsidized by DSD.
- Our service delivery area falls under the Magistrates Court in Caledon and vehicle maintenance costs and fuel expenses are very high to render services in the Hangklip / Kleinmond area.
- DSD does not provide any additional costs to this regard.

Your giving

- Cultivates one-to-one client programs and group activities.
- It allows us the freedom to give attention to the behavioral problems in the community that we do not receive government funding for.
- It allows us to provide 2 nutritious meals at our ECD Schools, 1 nutritious meal at the Aftercare Facility and 3 nutritious meals and snacks at the Overstrand Child and Youth Centre on a daily basis.

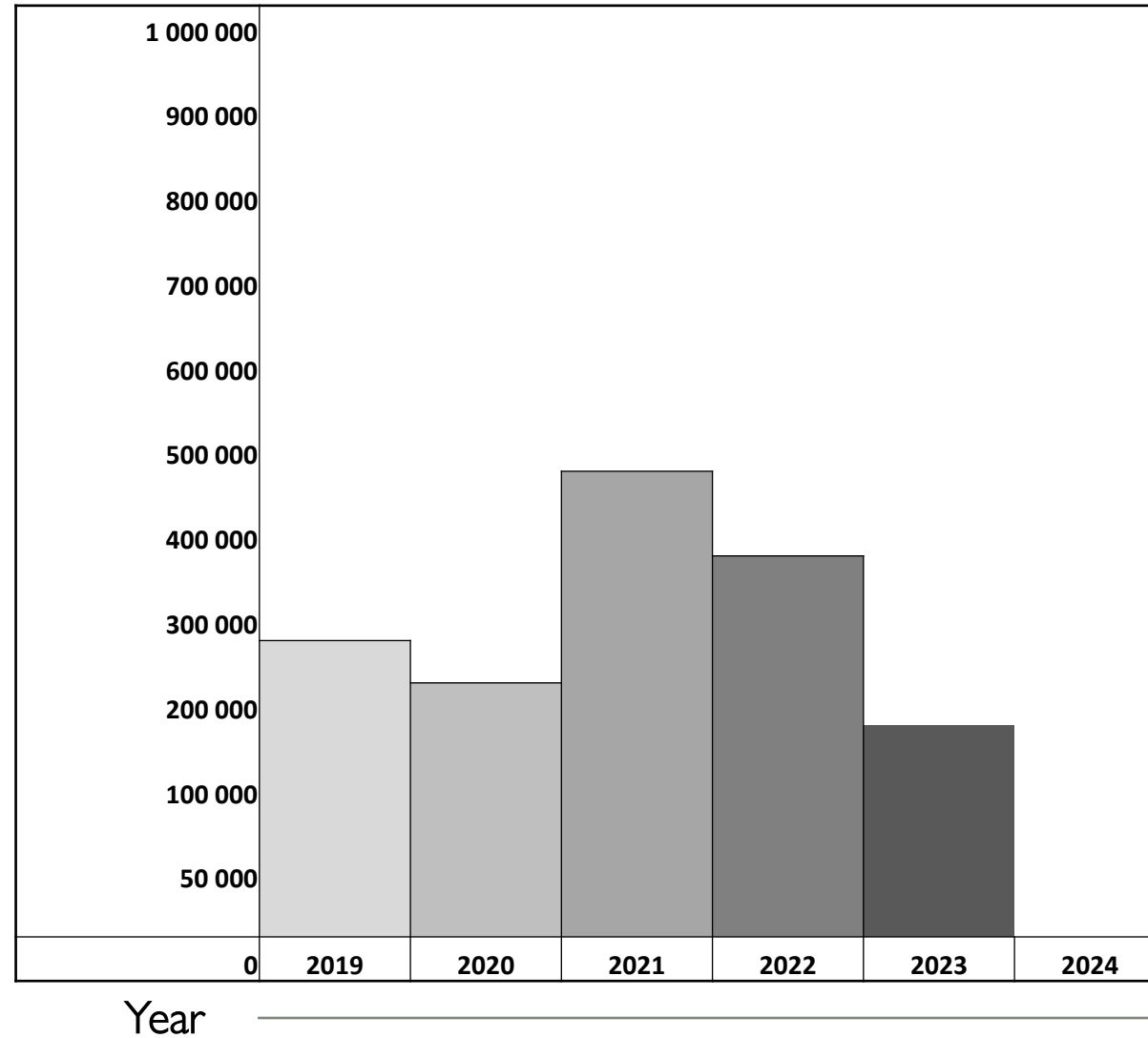
